

Semen sample for fertilization

These instructions are for the patients who are undergoing infertility treatments at the Turku University Hospital department of obstetrics and gynaecology.

The Fertility Laboratory is located next to the Gynecology Outpatient Clinic (Naistentautien vastaanotot K). A elevators, 6th floor.

The sperm used in the infertility treatments should be taken on a predetermined date and preferably at the **private sample room at the the Fertility Laboratory.** If this is not possible, the sample can be collected at home.

Taking the sample

We recommend that that 1 to 3 days have passed since the last ejaculation.

- Take the sample by masturbating directly into the container you have received for this purpose
- Do not use a condom, as it is harmful for the sperm.
- Try to collect all of the ejaculate.

Transport the sample within an hour to the fertility laboratory:

- On the day of the insemination between 7.30 8 am.
- On the day of the IVF/ICSI (on the day of the OPU procedure) at a separately scheduled time.

Protect the sample carefully from cold and hot temperatures during transportation. Transport the sample in a breast pocket. The sample can be stored in room temperature (20 degrees Celsius).

The semen sample **must be delivered personally** to the Fertility laboratory, where your **identity is verified** (bring a photo ID with you).
