

Fecal sample into dry sample container

This instruction is followed for these tests:

- VirVi (2975)
- F-Elast1 (1718)
- F-VirNhO (14157)
- F-ParaNhO (13844)
- SienVi, feces (2631)

Each of these tests requires a separate sample container.

Materials

- 1. Plastic or cardboard container.
- 2. Container for fecal sample (Figur 1).
- 3. Plastic bag and sticker for name.

Procedure

- 1. Defecate into the plastic or cardboard container or on toilet paper.
- 2. Open the container for the fecal sample. Using the spatula attached to the top, take about one spoonful of feces into the container (do not fill the container).
- 3. If you have diarrhea, take one tablespoonful into the container.
- 4. Close the container tightly.
- 5. Please be careful so that the outside of the container does not get sample on it.
- 6. Write your name, social security number, sampling date and sampling time on the sticker that came with the materials from the lab.
- 7. Attach the sticker to the sample container.
- 8. Put the sample container into the plastic bag.
- 9. Keep the sample container cool, preferably at refrigerator temperature.
