

Medication for iritis (inflammation of the iris)

Week 1

Cortisone drop (e.g. Dexa or Pred Forte®)
1–2 drops in the affected eye during waking hours

Pupil-dilating drop (e.g. Oftan Tropicamid®)
1 drop three times a day

Dexa or Ultracortenol cream for the night

Wait about 5–10 minutes between different drops!

Week 2

Dexa or Pred Forte drop every other hour while awake
Tropicamid 1 drop once a day
Dexa or Ultracortenol cream for the night

Week 3

Dexa or Pred Forte drop five times per day
Dexa or Ultracortenol cream for the night
No dilating drop

Weeks 4–6

Dexa drop 2–3 times per day

If you still have pain in your eye or if your vision is poor once treatment has ended, contact the Eye Clinic.

If you wish, you can schedule a check-up appointment with your own ophthalmologist in the private sector.
