

CRH stimulation test (Pt-CRH-R, 3132)

This examination is done to study the function of the pituitary gland and the adrenal cortex. CRH is the test substance used for this.

How to prepare yourself for the test

1. Don't drink or eat anything after 10:00 o'clock PM (22:00 hours) the evening before the test.
2. You may drink a glass of water in the morning.

There are many medicines that may affect the test result.

1. Tell your doctor all medicines you take - those you take regularly and those you take occasionally. Your doctor decides if you should stop taking a medicine before the test.

Procedure

1. First, a plastic cannula is inserted in a vein.
2. The test substance (CRH) is injected through this cannula. CRH might cause temporary heat rash on face, nausea and vertigo.
3. The blood samples are also collected through this cannula.
4. When all blood samples have been collected, the plastic cannula is removed from the vein.

The examination will take about 2.5 hours.
