

## **Galactography (Ductography)**

### **Patient instructions**

This test is done if you have abnormal secretions from your breast.

### **How to prepare for the examination?**

The examination does not require any preparation from you.

### **How is the examination done?**

During the examination, the Radiologist injects a contrast agent into the leaking milk duct. The Radiographer then takes the required number of x-rays of the breast with a mammography device. The study takes about 45 minutes.

### **What about after the examination?**

The breast may feel tender after examination. You will receive the results from your referring doctor.
